Did you know any association officer or director may nominate an individual for the South Dakota Bowling Hall of Fame? Even a fellow bowler can submit a request to you for someone to be nominated. Surely, there is a bowler in your Association that would welcome being nominated for one of the categories or you strongly feel deserves recognition.

Individuals may be nominated in more than one category. You as the nominating association MUST provide an accompanying letter verifying information and accomplishments of the nominee, including a minimum of seven (7) years' membership in the local association submitting the nomination. You will need to provide information for all categories checked on the nomination form. Recommended, but no longer required, a nominee may submit an autobiographical resume of his/her bowling career to help the committee learn more about the bowler. Let them know to just tell us the story of their life in bowling. The committee so enjoys hearing the wonderful stories told by the nominees.

Don't forget about the Pioneer Division for that individual who has made significant contributions to the health, growth and enjoyment of the sport of bowling. Basically, the person that bowls or did bowl for the love of the game.

Nominations will be considered for a period of four years, after which names may be resubmitted to the Hall of Fame Committee.

We look forward to receiving your nominations and thank you for your recommendations.
